# **Synopsis of Paper**

The Catholic Church has been at odds with Freemasonry for nearly 300 years. Chris Powell's paper examines the issues faced by English Catholics today, especially those who have joined the Craft. It considers issues of regularity and the many different freemasonries (plural) around the globe, and the Church's confused messages, especially since 1974 when for a decade Catholics in England were *de facto* permitted by the Vatican to become Freemasons.

The paper notes the differences between what was published in the Canons of 1983 and in Cardinal Ratzinger's Declaration of the same year. It also notes the sometimes erroneous statements published in the Catholic press by authors ill-informed about Freemasonry, especially English Freemasonry.

## About the Author

Christopher Powell was born at Lyme Regis, Dorset and educated at the universities of Sheffield and Cambridge. He taught in the University of Cambridge for five years before moving to Cardiff where for twenty-five years he was on the staff of the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama – the National Conservatoire of Wales. He held a number of senior academic and administrative posts and was for more than a decade a member of the academic board and governing body of the college. Having retired on his fiftieth birthday, he became a Freemason first in the Province of Derbyshire and then in Yorkshire West Riding.

Chris is a Past Master of Royal Brunswick Lodge No.296 and a Past Z of Chapter of Loyalty No. 296, both eighteenth-century foundations based in Sheffield. He is also a member of other Masonic bodies in England and Scotland. In 2009, he was awarded the Norman B. Spencer Prize and the following year elected a full member of QC lodge. He is the author of numerous papers published in AQC and in other Masonic journals, including those of the Manchester and Bristol Masonic research associations. He is also the author of Easy Lodge Music – a collection of familiar music for lodge use.
