## Synopsis of the paper

From almost its beginning, the Grand Lodge of London and Westminster faced two problems. Originally concerned with various Lodges in and around London it received a number of applications firstly from Lodges all over the country and then from all over the world asking for recognition from London. It was then faced with a statement from Lodges in Chester that they had elected their own Provincial Grand Master and asking for the Grand Master's approbation. Agreeing to such requests led by the end of the eighteenth century to a substantial growth in the number of such Provincial appointments, sometimes for Provinces where there were no Lodges recognised by Grand Lodge. Simultaneously there were a number of individuals, especially Thomas Dunckerley, who held the office of Provincial Grand Master of a number of Provinces at the same time and who did much to lay down the pattern of organisation which emerged during the nineteenth century.
